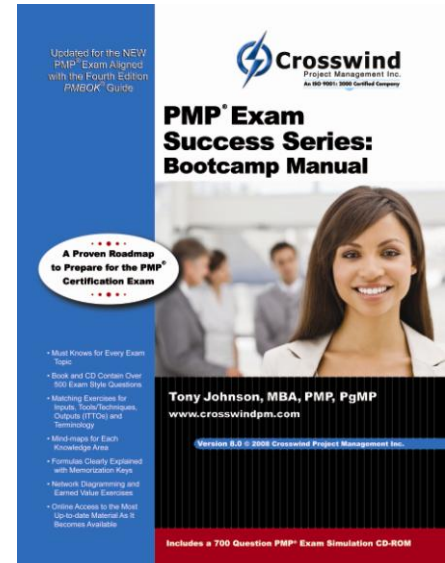

- **Project Human Resource Management** - gain an understanding of project people management including organizational planning, staff acquisition and team development
- **Professional Responsibility** - understand the PMI Code of Ethics and how it affects your behavior as a PMP
